**Bid No. (6868):** **Chepstowe Water Supply – Portland**  
The scope of work involves but is not limited to the construction of an entombment/dam at proposed source (Marsham Spring), connection of the new source to the existing system (Bybrook / Skibo water supply which is supplied by the clear spring source), installation of a chlorinator and sterilization system, installation of 1900m of 4" supply pipelines and 2500m of 2" distribution pipelines and installation of 250 laterals. The delivery/construction period is Four (4) months.

#### PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY ACCESS MANAGEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT POLICY CONSULTANCY SERVICES

The Ministry of Transport, Works and Housing invites Proposals for the provision of Consultancy services to review and finalize the Public Rights of Way Access Management and Enforcement Policy document and to prepare Drafting Instructions for the Rights of Way Act. The Policy, which is expected to provide a regulatory environment for the use of the Public Rights of Way, will, among other things, protect the Government's investment in road infrastructure, facilitate the structured access by telecommunication, utility and other companies to the Public Rights of Way and improve the safety of pedestrians and motorists.

**Eligibility:** Consultants must provide proof of membership in a Professional Organisation and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). International Consultants (if successful) will be required to submit a valid TCC within ten (10) days of notice of award of contract.

The scope of work involves but is not limited to the construction of entrance for main block, removal and replacement of existing doors and windows, updating of electrical and plumbing works (All works will include existing building with the exception of new recent construction), water proofing to roof areas, painting of existing building and installation of water harvesting system.
