The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the World Bank towards the cost of the **INTEGRATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (ICDP)**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover payments under the Integrated Infrastructure Projects contract.
