The Government of Jamaica has approved the institutionalization of the Public Investment Management System (PIMS) and, in doing so; standardize the treatment of public investment across the public sector with respect to the entire project cycle.

The purpose of this assignment is to design and develop a PIMS handbook that will be a detailed set of regulations to be used by all the stakeholders of the system to interpret and execute the requirements of the PIMS as set out in the legislation and operational guidelines. The consultancy will have duration of **2 months**.
