The projects are funded by the Universal Service Fund. The first project was implemented in partnership with the Ministry of Education focused on enhancing Jamaica's high schools and teachers' colleges, by providing digital content for CXC subjects, audiovisual and computing technology, and training teachers and lecturers in Basic ICT as well as the integration of technology in instructional delivery.

In an effort to deal with obsolescence and sustainability issues, e-Learning Jamaica is now seeking a suitably qualified partner(s) to upgrade the technology infrastructure in 180 high schools through the provision of additional computers, multimedia projectors and interactive projectors.
