This request for proposal follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in UN Development Business Reference No: IDB645-05/17.

The National Water Commission (NWC) of Jamaica has received grant financing from the Inter-American Development Bank, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to the contracting of consulting services under the non-reimbursable technical cooperation No. ATN/MA-15809-JA, Support to National Water Commission for Improvements in Corporatization & Institutional Strengthening. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's (IDB) eligibility rules and procedures.

The NWC, the executing agency for the Project, invites sealed proposals from eligible consulting firms who are nationals of member countries of the IDB for the supply of the consulting services. The NWC is seeking the services of a qualified and experienced consultant to provide the requisite assistance providing services to (i) define Corporate Governance (CG) improvements; (ii) prepare a detailed training plan for institutional strengthening of NWC's business planning and Operation and Maintenance (O&M) protocols; and conducting a tariff study that is then used to prepare a proposal for revisions in its current tariff for submission to the Office of Utilities Regulation Jamaica (OUR).
