In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen and promote Public Procurement, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MoFPS), Procurement and Asset Policy Unit (PAPU) is on a drive to expand the use of the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement System (GOJEP) to its suppliers of goods, services and works. This is keeping with the commitment of the Government to have all procurement opportunities published and managed through GOJEP by 2018.

Suppliers are being urged to register their businesses in GOJEP and take advantage of the free training sessions facilitated by the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service on the use of the system. Please note that the Ministry will be undertaking a series of sessions in the Western region for the period **September 2017**.

The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project (FCGP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services. Most of the activities to be supported by the project involve the provision of technical assistance through consulting services. As such, the engagement of a technical analyst to provide guidance and support in drafting of TORs at this juncture in Project implementation is viewed as critical.

The consulting services ("the Services") is to provide technical support to the PEU in the definition and design of studies, technical and analytical work to be funded under the FCGP, by collaborating with MDAs in the preparation and costing of TORs. The activities to be undertaken include, but not limited to, effectively collaborating with responsible MDAs and the relevant Lead Coordinating Agency/ Component Coordinator in defining the scope of work to be undertaken and the TORs which will guide the consulting services required and assessing existing draft TORs and make improvements based on agreed quality standards in consultation with sponsoring MDAs and the relevant Lead Coordinating Agency/Component Coordinator.

If successful, an **international bidder**, while not required to submit Jamaican TCC and NCC certificates prior to contract award, must demonstrate tax compliance in country of registration.
