The Government of Jamaica has received funding from the International Development Bank towards the cost for the Strengthening of the Institutional Capacity of the Financial Services Commission (FSC) and intends to apply part proceeds for consulting services. Component one (1) of the project focuses on the re-engineering of business processes of the FSC for which this Expression of Interest (EOI) is issued.

The FSC has determined that its operational transformation requires processes enabled by just-in-time digital operating support systems that will enable the collection, management, analysis, and distribution of data and information. The FSC is seeking to document and analyse current processes across the organization, examine their suitability for operational transformation and where necessary, re-engineer them for fitness and their seamless integration with digital operating support platforms.

The Consultant will be required to ensure the achievement of the following objectives:

- Perform an assessment of existing business process and its supporting hardware/software infrastructure;
- Develop new business processes that will enable the operational transformation of the FSC;
- Assess the fitness of re-engineered business processes for integration with digital operating support platforms;
- Document the existing and re-engineered FSC business processes;
- Propose infrastructure changes to meet the newly developed processes;
- Propose an organizational-wide system that will incorporate the new business processes, infrastructure changes and a technology platform that will achieve our business objectives in an efficient and user-friendly manner; and
- Prepare a cost estimate for the development of the aforementioned electronic system that will support and facilitate the new business processes.
