### INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION

The Government of Jamaica has received a loan from the World Bank towards the cost of the **INTEGRATED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT (ICDP)**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover payments under the following contracts.

The Jamaica Social Investment Fund intends to Prequalify Civil Works Contractors registered with the National Contracts Commission (NCC) for the following Projects.

**Bid No. 7695 Retirement Integrated Infrastructure Project, St. James (#073412)** The proposed scope of works entails but is not limited to the rehabilitation of approximately 1.89 km of roadway, installation of 2.28 km of PVC water pipes (100 mm), construction of approximately 50 m3 of Random Rubble Wall.

**Bid No. 7709 Denham Town Integrated Infrastructure Project, Kingston (#073418)** The proposed scope of works involves but is not limited to the rehabilitation of approximately 3.05 Km of roadway which includes the milling and re-surfacing of 2637 m of roadway and 410 m of roadway, the installation of 6.99 km of PVC water pipes (100 mm and 150 mm) including installation of fire hydrants, the patching of 2609 m2 of roadway and the flushing of existing sewer lines.

**Bid No. 7710 Greenwich Town Integrated Infrastructure Project, Kingston (#073414)** The proposed scope of works entails but is not limited to the installation of 4,150 m of 100 mm diameter PVC water pipes, the installation of 1,000 m of 150 mm diameter PVC water pipes, installation of 5,710 m of 200 mm diameter PVC sewer pipes including the installation of approximately 10,380 m of 100 mm diameter laterals and reinstatement of approximately 11,000 m of roadways.
