REGISTRATION AND TRAINING AVAILABLE FOR USE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF JAMAICA ELECTRONIC PROCUREMENT SYSTEM SUPPLIERS OF GOODS, SERVICES AND WORKS

In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen and promote Public Procurement, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MoFPS), Procurement and Asset Policy Unit (PAPU) is on a drive to expand the use of the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement System (GOJEP) to its suppliers of goods, services and works. This is keeping with the commitment of the Government to have all procurement opportunities published and managed through GOJEP by 2018.

Suppliers are being urged to register their businesses in GOJEP and take advantage of the free training sessions facilitated by the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service on the use of the system. Please note that the Ministry will be undertaking a series of sessions in the Western region for the period **September 2017**.

The first session will be conducted on Friday September 15, 2017 between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. For confirmation and registration please contact the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service, Procurement and Asset Policy Unit.

The Culture, Health, Arts, Sports and Education (CHASE) Fund invites sealed bids from eligible **CONTRACTORS** for the proposed **“Construction, Renovation & Refurbishing”** of the following infant school and community centre:

- **New Forest Infant School - Manchester**
- **Elleston Flats Community Centre – Kingston 7**

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

New Forest Infant School – 7 months

Construction of a new 4 classroom school building with sickbay, kitchen, office and bathroom facilities (teachers & students).

Elleston Flats Community Centre – 3 months

The works to be executed consist of the renovation of a community centre comprising the replacement of a timber-framed roof with suspended concrete slab, re-tiling floors and fitting windows and doors with an approximate gross floor area of 155 square meters.

ELIGIBILITY

It is mandatory that contractors be registered with the National Contracts Commission in the category of “Building Construction” **Grade 2** and above for New Forest Infant School and **Grade 4** and above for Elleston Flats Community Centre.

All bidders must be **Tax Compliant** at the bid opening. Bidding will be in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (**March 2014**).

AVAILABILITY OF BID DOCUMENTS

Eligible bidders can obtain tender Documents as of **Monday, September 18, 2017 to Friday, September 22, 2017** between **9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** at the office of: CHASE Fund, 8 Belmont Road, Kingston 5. A non-refundable fee of **Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)** in cash or Manager's cheque made payable to CHASE will be required for each set of tender documents. All queries concerning the Tender documents/drawings shall be made in writing to the Chief Executive Officer, CHASE, 8 Belmont Road, Kingston 5.

SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The Tender/s along with the required documents i.e. NCC certificate of registration, a valid TCC/ TCL and Tender Bond are to be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the designated tender box provided marked with the name of the respective school & community centre which is located in the waiting area of the CHASE Office, 8 Belmont Road, Kingston 5 at or before **2:00 p.m., Friday, October 6, 2017**. **Late Bids will be rejected.**

Tender envelopes will be opened publicly on **Friday, October 6, 2017** in the main conference room at CHASE Fund, 8 Belmont Road, Kingston 5 at the following times:
