The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received loan financing from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) towards the cost of the Strategic Public Sector Transformation Project (SPSTP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the consulting services. The Project Development Objective (PDO) is to strengthen public resource management and support selected public sector institutions in facilitating a more enabling environment for private sector growth.

The Financial Administration and Audit (Amendment) Act 2014 – Fourth Schedule (Section 48B (2) provides that an element of the Public Investment Management System shall be a Public Investment Performance Report. This is a comprehensive performance report on the Government's Public Investment Programme, which shall be produced and published periodically by the Ministry.

The Consultant is required to develop a Public Investment Performance Report as required by the FAA Act.

The consultancy will have a duration of 2 months.

The Ministry of Finance and the Public Service now invites eligible individual consultants to indicate their interest in providing the consultancy service. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the service.
