Opening of tenders will take place at **10:15 a.m.** on the same day, in the Conference Room at 18 Oxford Road. Applicants or representatives are invited to the opening.

Pre-qualified brokers and insurers will be required to submit in their tenders:

- (1) Copies of valid Tax Compliance Certificates (TCC) indicating tax compliance at time of submission of tenders and
- (2) Copies of valid NCC registration
- (3) Proof of Professional Liability (E&O) cover (minimum of US\$7.5 million)

Period of placement will be for three (3) years.

The National Water Commission is not obliged to accept the lowest priced proposal but in respect of the best overall proposal(s). The "Tender Box" is located in the Cashier's Section, to the immediate left upon entering the building at 18 Oxford Road.

INVITATION TO PRE-QUALIFY FOR THE NATIONAL TEXTBOOK LOAN SCHEME 2018-2019

The Government of Jamaica, through the Ministry of Education, Youth & Information, invites companies registered with the National Contracts Commission in the category of "Stationery Supplies and Books" to pre-qualify for the procurement and distribution of textbooks to All-Age, Primary and Junior High and Secondary schools islandwide, under the National Textbook Loan Scheme 2018-2019, with particular emphasis on materials locally prepared and produced.

In order to pre-qualify, companies will be assessed on the experience of assigned staff, value of contracts handled, timely management of jobs completed, financial capabilities of the firm, availability of warehouse space and vehicles, and years of experience in executing similar work in Jamaica (see marking sheet overleaf).

Companies must also be in possession of a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) in order to pre-qualify.

Complete sets of pre-qualification documents may be obtained as of **Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at a non-refundable cost of \$4,000.00** which is to be paid at 2-4 National Heroes Circle, Cashier's Desk, Building 1, 2nd floor, and collected at:

There will be a public opening of the Pre-Qualification Documents at 2:15 p.m. on Tuesday, January 23, 2018 in the Architecture Conference Room, Georgian Building, in the presence of bidders and/or their representatives who choose to attend.

COMPANIES MUST SCORE A MINIMUM OF SIXTY PER CENT (60%) OF THE TOTAL MARKS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SUBMIT BIDS FOR TEXTBOOKS.
