This is keeping with the commitment of the Government to have all procurement opportunities published and managed through GOJEP by 2018.a

Suppliers are being urged to register their businesses in GOJEP and take advantage of the free training sessions facilitated by the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service in the use of the system.

The Government of Jamaica, through the Public Sector Transformation and Modernisation Division (PSTMD) of the Cabinet Office has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB)/China Co-financing Fund for Latin America and the Caribbean, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for the Delivery of Information Security Management Systems (ISMS) Training to benefit the Information Technology Community of the Government of Jamaica.

The Public Sector Transformation and Modernisation Division (PSTMD) invites eligible firms to indicate their interest in providing the above service. Interested consultants should provide information demonstrating the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. This assignment requires an estimated level of effort equivalent to one (1) year from a suitable consulting firm.

Shortlists shall comprise six firms with a wide geographic spread, with no more than two firms from any one country.

The consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for the Selection and Contracting of Consultants financed by the Inter-American Development Bank (GN-2350-9), **March 2011**, and is open to all eligible firms as defined in the policies.
