The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received a grant through the World Bank (WB) under the Pilot Programme for Climate Resilience (PPCR) toward the cost of implementing the **Improving Climate Data and Information Management Project (ICDIMP)**. A portion of the proceeds of this grant will be for consulting services.

The objectives of this consultancy are to:

1. Undertake a structural assessment of the Meteorological Services Jamaica (MSJ) radar supporting tower located in Cooper's Hill for signs of structural deterioration or defects and if required, recommend appropriate rehabilitation actions
2. Conduct a building condition assessment of the MSJ radar station (office) located in Cooper's Hill and prepare a scope of work and preliminary costing for refurbishing the site
3. Assess the condition of the water supply system and prepare a scope of work and preliminary costing for refurbishing/improving the system
4. Recommend the most suitable type of perimeter fencing for the office facility including a preliminary costing for erection.

The consultancy will have duration of **one month**.

The Planning Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible individuals (consultants) to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services (description of similar assignments undertaken). The selection criteria are:

1. A Degree in Civil Engineering
2. 7-10 years working experience in structural engineering or related field
3. Candidates should have carried out similar assignments in the past 5 years
4. Experience in developing preliminary costings for civil works
5. Proficiency in English with experience in preparing technical reports

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's **Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers dated January 2011 revised July 2014 ("Consultant Guidelines")**, setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
