NAME OF CONTRACT

CHASE Pre & Post Construction Contract Management Services 2016-2019.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES

CHASE Fund intends to establish a frame work agreement with four consultants/ consulting organizations to which projects will be assigned to provide Pre Contract and Post Contract services such as:

- Preparation of all necessary architectural and engineering drawings
- Preparation of Bills of Quantities
- Preparation of tender reports.
- Contract monitoring

The panel of consultants will serve for a prescribed period of time.
