



REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

For Consulting Services to Conduct Energy Audits for the  
implementation of the School Solar PV Pilot Project

The Ministry of Education and The National Education Trust (NET) have identified the need to install Solar Photovoltaic (PV) panels in **thirty (30) secondary schools** across the island as a means of reducing the electricity costs at these institutions. The National Education Trust now invites eligible firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing "the services" to **conduct Level Two (2) energy audits** to determine levels of energy efficiency and make recommendations to improve same. This is expected to commence by **September 2016** with a duration of **3 months**. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The short-listing criteria will be an evaluation of the following submissions:

- Energy Auditor who is approved by Development Bank of Jamaica
- Engineers with Certified Energy Management (CEM)
- At least three (3) years' experience in energy auditing
- At least a B.Sc. Engineering
- Registration with the Professional Engineers Registration Board (PERB).

Expressions of Interest should be accompanied by a detailed profile of the firm/s along with a statement of capability. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the QCBS methodology procedures set out in the GOJ Handbook of Procurement Guidelines (2014). Additionally, all prospective consultants **MUST** possess a valid Tax Compliant Certificate (TCC). A copy of the Terms of Reference will be made available upon request.
