Consulting services are being sought to provide strategic guidance on the considerations in developing the **Milk River Mineral Bath (MRMB)** and the **Bath Fountain Hotel & Spa (BFHS)** under a PPP arrangement. This advice will enable the Government to assess the PPP structuring options available and to determine how best the project can be promoted to attract private investors and maximize the GoJ's value for money.
