TENDER FOR BRIDGE PROTECTION WORKS: RIO MINHO BRIDGE (MAY PEN BYPASS), CLARENDON

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for Bridge Protection Works for the Rio Minho Bridge located in the parish of Clarendon. The works consist of the supply, delivery and placement of various size boulders and support material to protect the bridge structure.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grades 1 to 4 in the Civil Engineering Works Categories.

Availability: Tender Documents will be made available as of **Tuesday, June 16, 2015**, at the National Works Agency, Corporate Office, 140 Maxfield Avenue, Kingston 10, in the Directorate of Regional Implementation & Special Projects.
