The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

Consulting services are being sought to prepare an assessment of existing Downtown Kingston Development Plans and an implementation framework for the redevelopment of Downtown Kingston.

Results to be achieved by the consultant include:

- A mapping of land ownership, tenure and use (proposed and actual) in Downtown Kingston, with a view towards enhancement for future use.
- Proposed consensus definition of a Downtown Kingston Redevelopment Area.
- Market Analysis to support the redevelopment of Downtown Kingston.
- Review of current incentive mechanisms and proposal of a modernized incentive regime, tied to specific macro-economic objectives such as employment creation, to support the redevelopment of Downtown Kingston.
- A consolidated, time-bound action plan for the redevelopment of Downtown Kingston.
