Abstract: THE PHASED IMPLEMENTATION OF AN ERP SYSTEM TO REPLACE THE EXISTING FIS IS GEARED TOWARDS A PROCESS WHICH WILL ALLOW THE NWC TO BETTER MANAGE THE REQUIRED CAPITAL OUTLAY OVER A REASONABLE PERIOD OF TIME.

The specific objectives of the ERP implementation are (i) eliminating the risk associated with the reliance on the existing FIS, for which currently only obsolescence support is available; (ii) reducing the level of capital outlay to manageable levels by way of a phased implementation. (iii) strengthening NWC's performance in terms of operation and maintenance practices.

The National Water Commission now wishes to use the experienced ERP Software Solution providers to identify and integrate with its other Information Technology Systems; a suitable ERP solution to enhance the institutional capacity of the enterprise and to effectively manage its resources.

The main activities will be to identify matching modules in the existing FIS, with the proposed solution which will be implemented in phase one (1) and based on the overall requirements of the NWC, determine how many additional phase(s) will be required, in order to meet the need of keeping the outlay of capital in each phase at a manageable level.

Expressions of Interest (EOI) must be delivered to the address below on or before **October 22, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.** (Kingston, Jamaica time). All firms submitting an Expression of Interest (EOI) should submit in hard copy one (1) original and two (2) copies along with one (1) copy in electronic format. The EOI should be accompanied by (i) details, with references, of projects successfully delivered that demonstrate competence in ERP implementation/integration, (ii) Audited Financial Statements for the last three years for which audited accounts are available, and (iii) statements of appropriate capacity and capability within the organisation.

Expressions of Interest will be evaluated to prepare a short-list of no more than six firms. The short-listed firms will be invited to submit Technical and Price Proposals on the basis of a Request for Proposals (RFP) issued to them by the NWC.
