Assignment Title: **SPECIALIST SERVICE FOR THE MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF THE USE OF AMANDA IN THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND REFERRAL AGENCIES**

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the **Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") include: an Application Management and Data Automation (AMANDA) Specialist to provide strategic and operational support, particularly to support the technical and implementation teams of the Ministry of Local Government and Community Development (MLGCD) and National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA). The consultancy will be required to provide support to the technical and implementation teams working on the development applications process (DAP) as an additional resource that will monitor and track the automation of the DAP through use of the AMANDA system.

Results to be achieved by the Consultant are as follows:

1. Provide user support in the upgrade and use of the AMANDA systems in all Local Authorities and referral agencies;
2. Monitor and evaluate the use and operation of AMANDA in the Local Authorities (Kingston and St Andrew Corporation, Parish Councils, Portmore Municipal Council and Negril Green Island Planning Authority (NGILPA)) and referral agencies; and
3. Measure the impact of the use of the software on the development applications process and business sector.

The duration of the Consultancy is expected to be no more than **24 months**.
