The Evaluation Instrument will be used to assess key performance standards for Boards of Public Bodies.

The Ministry of Finance & Planning (MoFP) now invites eligible and qualified individuals to submit full Curriculum Vitae for Consultancy Services as a performance Evaluation Consultant in the Ministry of Finance and Planning (MoFP) for a period of eighty (80) days.
