Spectrum Management Authority invites suitably qualified, professional entities operating and duly registered with the respective local professional bodies in Jamaica in keeping with the GOJ Procurement Guidelines to provide information in respect of the abovementioned project.

Background

The Spectrum Management Authority (SMA) is an agency of the Ministry of Science, Technology, Energy and Mining (MSTEM) with responsibility for regulating and managing the radio frequency spectrum (a range of frequencies used for wireless communication) in Jamaica.

In carrying out its mandate, the Authority ensures a relatively interference free spectrum for licensed users, the consistent application of equitable fees, and ensures that spectrum is available for new technologies.

In keeping with the Government of Jamaica's National Energy Policy 2009 – 2030 (NEP), which aims at energy efficiency improvement and energy diversification to obtain high-quality, affordable, environmentally friendly energy and to reduce the country's dependence on high-cost imported oil, the SMA seeks to procure an alternative energy solution for its Head Office at 13-19 Harbour Street, Kingston, Jamaica.

Purpose of the RFI

The purpose of this RFI is to obtain input, gather knowledge, new ideas, best practices and information from the vendor community for the potential procurement of products or services related to energy efficiency, including but not limited to alternative energy solutions inclusive of wind, heat and/or bio-fuels. Information gathered from this RFI will assist the SMA in its continued development of energy efficiency strategies, programs and capital improvement projects that incorporate alternative energy elements consistent with the GOJ National Energy Policy. The responses to the RFI will assist the SMA in its preparation of future Requests for Proposal (RFP's) and subsequent contracts.

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received funds from the Adaptation Fund grant number GOJ/AF_MOU 2013-NJM-1 for the "Enhancing Resilience of the Agriculture Sector and Coastal Areas to Protect Livelihoods and Improve Food Security" Programme. The National Environment and Planning Agency (NEPA) is responsible for the development of guidelines and technical standards for coastline development and protection under Component 3 of the Programme.

Proposals are being requested from Consultants Firms/Team to be engaged over a **7-month period** to:

1. Prepare guidelines and technical standards for beach restoration and shoreline protection in Negril; and
