Jamaica was selected to host the 2017 International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) Conference, an international conference for the securities markets across over 115 jurisdictions globally. IOSCO is the international body that governs securities regulators worldwide and is recognized for establishing global benchmarks for the securities sector. IOSCO develops, implements and promotes adherence to internationally recognized standards for securities regulation.

The **Financial Services Commission (FSC)**, as the regulator for the Securities, Insurance, and Private Pensions industries in Jamaica will spearhead the planning, organization and execution of the IOSCO Conference 2017. In order to ensure the seamless execution of this historic event, the first of its kind in the Caribbean, the FSC seeks to engage the services of an Events Planning Firm specialized in conference organization.

The Events Planning Firm will be expected to perform the following duties:

1. Develop and monitor the project and budget for the event, according to IOSCO's manual/rules, as well as other FSC required guidelines.
2. Prepare a detailed project schedule and manage the project according to the schedule.
3. Procure and manage suppliers needed for the event.
4. Develop communication plan and coordinate sponsorship activities.
5. Develop and coordinate registration system, according to IOSCO and FSC needs.
6. Prepare floor plans for the event which must meet IOSCO requirements.
7. Develop reports that IOSCO and FSC requires, post and pre event.
8. Coordinate logistics and transportation requirements for the execution of the event.

The services of the Events Planning Firm will be required for approximately fourteen (14) months

2. Proven experience in planning and executing annual meetings and conferences held by international organizations for delegates such as The United Nations (UN) and The International Investment Funds Association (IIFA) and from various jurisdictions, culture and religions.
