Energy Management solutions which will: develop a road map for comprehensive energy management at NMIA, examine all energy (including renewable) sources and develop and analyze scenarios for future energy demand and supply structures to fit the energy efficiency model and will help to sensitize airport population to energy-saving solutions.

Waste Management solutions that conform to the Environmental Management Program's strategic goals and will: Undertake on-site surveys and assessments to provide baseline technical data (qualitative and quantitative) that may guide further improvements in respect of the collection, transfer, recycling and disposal of all four (4) major classes of waste, i.e. International Waste (Class 1); Airport Waste (Class 2);

Construction Waste (Class 3); and Hazardous Materials Waste (Class 4) at NMIA
Water Management solutions that will: aid in the completion of a Water System Audit that reviews existing water uses and network infrastructure; provide an overview of the water management systems of NMIA, assist the entity's effort to develop a preservation and maintenance plan to mitigate loss, water restrictions and sustained drought conditions which are potentially amplified by climate change conditions.
