### INVITATION FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

#### THE OBJECTIVE OF THE CONSULTANCY INCLUDE

The main objective of this project is selection of an Individual Consultant to design the renovation of the customer service department at the office of the Ministry – 14 National Heroes Circle, Kingston 4.

#### SCOPE OF WORK

- The Individual Consultant shall take into consideration the expectations of the different users and discuss both solutions and problems to guide infrastructural modifications and designs. The Consultant should ensure that stakeholders articulate design preferences regarding the features to be included, i.e., access to persons with disabilities, wheelchairs, bathroom access and so on
- Conduct site visits to location and provide information to the MLSS on condition of the structures/environment and report on the feasibility of infrastructure works to be completed, while providing technical and environmental specifications of the existing infrastructure
- Preparation of technical drawings reflective of the needs of the users and stakeholders – Consultant should take into consideration funding constraints and thus prepare a phased design where applicable and or necessary
- Share with the Permanent Secretary and staff members technical drawings and compare with needs and expectations that were discussed with the stakeholders prior to formulation
- Provide a copy of the preliminary design to the stakeholders and allow for at least a two week period for stakeholders to review and provide sign off.
- Prepare a detailed Bills of Quantities using the format supplied by the MLSS or that of industry standard
- Ensure the input of all Agencies and Line Ministries in Final Design. Written Approval should be received from these Agencies and Line Ministries regarding Final Design. In the case of approving agencies (Parish Council, NEPA, as required) drawings are to be submitted for approval
- Ensure that a plan is in place to facilitate users during construction or rehabilitation. If necessary, make recommendations for minor works as required supported by design and costing documents

Given the fact that the facility and the service it offers to the general public, and more so the vulnerable nature of the Clients served by the facility including the elderly and persons with disabilities; the design Consultant must deliver a design and construction methodology and approach which reflects considerations of (i) short construction time (ii) low maintenance and operational costs and (iii) safe and comfortable environment.

The Design Consultant is therefore encouraged to consider a method of construction that would encourage a fast turnaround time (approximately two months), in order to minimize disruption to the staff and beneficiaries.

The Integrated Social Protection Project now invites eligible Individual Consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested Consultants may submit expressions of interest for the above services.
