The National Water Commission (NWC) of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to the contracting of consulting services under the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) Water Supply Improvement Programme. Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's (IDB) eligibility rules and procedures.

The NWC, the executing agency for the Programme, invites sealed proposals from eligible consulting firms who are nationals of member countries of the IDB for the supply of the consulting services. The NWC is seeking the services of a qualified and experienced consultant to provide detailed design and engineering services (inclusive of detailed bills of quantities, detailed construction drawings and tender documents) for the replacement/upgrading of the 525 mm (21") nominal diameter transmission main that runs from the Stanton Terrace Control Station (situated in the vicinity of its intersection with Herb McKenley Drive) to a Sump Station on the NWC's Marescaux Road property.
