The Ministry of Water, Land, Environment and Climate Change (MWLECC), acting as Executing Agency for the **Adaptation Programme and Financing Mechanism (AP&FM) Project of the Pilot Programme for Climate Resilience (PPCR) Jamaica**, funded by the Climate Investment Fund through the Inter-American Development Bank (IADB) (JA-L1048/JA-G1002), is desirous of engaging the services of individual consultants to fill the positions identified below for its Project Executing Unit (PEU). The PEU is responsible for the overall fiduciary, administrative, financial management and technical functions (including planning, coordination, supervision, staffing, procurement, monitoring and evaluation) in the implementation of the AP&FM of the PPCR Jamaica.

Applications are invited to fill the following positions:

1. **Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist in the PEU**
Objective of the Assignment: The Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist will report to the Project Manager and will operate from the Project Executing Unit (PEU). S/he will be responsible for the implementation of monitoring, reporting and evaluation activities of the Project.
Qualifications: Minimum requirements for the **M&E specialist** include at least a Master's degree in Business Administration, Finance, Natural Resource Management and/or related discipline. The candidate must have at least **7 years of M&E** related experience and extensive knowledge of monitoring and evaluation methodologies. Additionally, the candidate must also have a solid knowledge of questionnaire design; experience working with and maintaining good relations with international, as well as national counterparts and beneficiaries (e.g. local NGOs and government representatives); as well as solid experience in the management of people and systems. The M&E specialist must also have knowledge and experience on gender issues and/or must agree to be trained in the context of the project when necessary.
Duration: This consultancy will have duration of one **(1) year**, renewable for further periods up to the end of the Project, by mutual agreement.
2. **Communications Consultant**
Objective of the Assignment: The Communications Consultant will coordinate the Knowledge Management Component of the Project as well as the general promotional activities of the other project components. S/he will have the overall responsibility for developing, managing, co-coordinating, networking, implementing and monitoring the dissemination of project activities and associated products on an on-going basis with diverse public audiences (public and private sector, academic, civil society, project target communities, project co-implementing agencies and other relevant stakeholders).
Qualifications: Minimum requirements for the Communications Consultant include at least a Bachelor's Degree in Communication, Journalism, Public Relations or related field from a recognized tertiary institution; and minimum 6 years of relevant work experience in the communications and public relations field. In addition, the following experience will be considered an asset: Excellent writing and public speaking skills; Working with communities and non-governmental organizations; Working with government, development agencies, and/or International Organizations; and Experience on Graphic Design.
Duration: This consultancy will have a level of Effort of 160 person days annually with duration of one (1) year, renewable for further periods up to the end of the Project, by mutual agreement.
