PROCUREMENT OF PHARMACEUTICAL PREPARATIONS 2016-2018 Pharmaceutical: ICB: RX 2 2016

University Hospital of the West Indies invites bidders to purchase tender documents to supply pharmaceutical preparations, as listed in the Schedule of Requirements of the tender documents, for a 24-month contract period.

For tenders to be considered, bidders must submit the following:

- 1. Copy of valid National Contracts Commission (NCC) Certification in the category of 'Medical, Pharmaceutical Equipment and Supplies'.
- 2. Copy of valid Tax Compliant Certificate (TCC).
- 3. Bid security in the amount of Three Thousand United States dollars (US\$ 3,000.00) or its Jamaican equivalent using conversion rate of US\$1:JA\$120.00.
- 4. A completed and signed Bid Form.
- 5. A copy of the Ministry of Health's (Jamaica) Pharmaceutical Product Licence for all pharmaceutical preparations offered.
- 6. Relevant pharmaceutical samples: one sample in the package size being tendered, for pharmaceutical preparations not previously supplied to the University Hospital of the West Indies.
- 7. Manufacturer's Authorization where applicable.
- 8. Testimonials where applicable: All suppliers, not previously awarded contracts for the supply of pharmaceutical preparations, shall furnish documentary evidence, as to prior experience and ability to perform.
