PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY ACCESS MANAGEMENT AND ENFORCEMENT POLICY CONSULTANCY SERVICES

The Ministry of Transport, Works and Housing invites Proposals for the provision of **Consultancy services** to review and finalize the Public Rights of Way Access Management and Enforcement Policy document and to prepare Drafting Instructions for the Rights of Way Act. The Policy, which is expected to provide a regulatory environment for the use of the Public Rights of Way, will, among other things, protect the Government's investment in road infrastructure, facilitate the structured access by telecommunication, utility and other companies to the Public Rights of Way and improve the safety of pedestrians and motorists.

Eligibility: Consultants must provide proof of membership in a Professional Organisation and a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC). International Consultants (if successful) will be required to submit a valid TCC within ten (10) days of notice of award of contract.

This request for proposal follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in UN Development Business Reference No: **IDB1410-813/11.**

The National Water Commission (NWC) of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank, and intends to apply part of the proceeds to the contracting of **consulting services under the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA) Water Supply Improvement Programme.** Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's (IDB) eligibility rules and procedures.

The NWC, the executing agency for the Programme, invites sealed proposals from eligible consulting firms who are nationals of member countries of the IDB for the supply of the consulting services. The NWC is seeking the services of a qualified and experienced consultant to provide detailed design and engineering services (inclusive of detailed bills of quantities, detailed construction drawings and tender documents) for the replacement/upgrading of the following sections of the potable water transmission mains serving areas in Kingston & St. Andrew:

- The 800 mm nominal diameter cast iron (CI) transmission main from Six Miles (intersection of Mandela Highway & Spanish Town Road) to Glenmore Road Booster (Glenmore Road/South Camp Road intersection).
- The 600 mm nominal diameter CI transmission main from the Molyneux Road Booster Station (Molyneux Road/Washington Boulevard intersection) to Dunrobin Road/Constant Spring Road intersection.
- The section from Mandela Highway and Spanish Town Road intersection to Duhaney Drive, and
- The section crossing Sandy Gully Bridge on Washington Boulevard.
