The Government of Jamaica (GoJ) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Foundations for Competitiveness and Growth Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include:

The Ministry of Education (Ministry) and National Education Trust Limited (NET) have identified the need to install Photovoltaic (solar) panels in thirty (30) secondary schools across the island as a means of reducing the electricity costs at these institutions.

The panels will be roof mounted taking into consideration factors such as climatic conditions, latitude, altitude and the level and variation of the input solar radiation. NET wishes to explore this project as a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) in keeping with the PPP Policy of the Government of Jamaica (GoJ) and the fiscal rules as outlined in the Public Bodies Management and Accountability Act. NET thus intends to procure the services of a consulting firm for transaction advisory services to assist it through the phases of the PPP project cycle.

The objectives of the Consultancy are as follows:

Phase I: Undertake a Business Case review and prepare a Transactions Structuring Options Report for the Project.

Phase II: Provide transaction advisory services for the procurement and contract management advice for the project.
