DESCRIPTION OF WORKS:

The contractor will be required to undertake the rehabilitation of road pavements inclusive of asphaltic double surface treatment, drainage improvement (culverts, kerb & channel) and some asphaltic concrete cross drains and surface patching.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TENDER:

Tenderers must provide: A valid Tax Compliance Certificate / Letter (TCC/TCL). A valid National Contract Commission (NCC) registration certificate indicating a **minimum Grade rating as outlined in the category of General Road Work**. A tender bond in the prescribed form, stamped by the Commissioner of Stamp Duty in the amount of not less than 2% of the total tender price or a manager's/certified cheque in the amount no less than 1% of the total tender price.

This request for Expressions of Interest follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in the **UN Development Business No. IDB44-01/13 of 15 January, 2013**.

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the **Inter-American Development Bank (IDB)**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under the project "Integrated Social Protection and Labour Programme". Bidding will be governed by the Inter-American Development Bank's eligibility rules and procedures.

The project intends to apply part of the loan proceeds to payments under the contract for the captioned consultancy service.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CONSULTANCY

The services of Consulting Firm will be engaged by the Ministry of Labour and Social Security (MLSS) to undertake an eight (8) months public education campaign geared at increasing responsiveness to the Labour Market Information System (LMIS). The Consulting Firm is to design, direct, produce and place a multimedia campaign which reaches the target audiences for the campaign with the messages that have been developed. The Target Audiences shall be Employers, Job seekers, Investors, Students and other stakeholders.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Review existing LMIS literature in order to gain a comprehensive knowledge of the operations of the programme.
- Interview stakeholders to identify gaps within the image of LMIS.
- Develop a budget and itemize list of goods and services that will be required to deliver the services
- Draft for the review of the Ministry's Public Relations Unit and the LMIS team the appropriate scripts for the development of radio feature based on the messages that are to be sent to the clients.
- Develop and produce one 5- minute radio feature with 10 spots to be included in media.
- Rebroadcast one 10-minute television feature with 8 slots to be included in the media.
- Design and place one top banner on a Government Agency website.
- Design and place one bus wrap (driver side panel) for 6 months.
- Produce one 30-second jingle, encouraging persons to register and utilize the services of the LMIS.
- Place one 30-second jingle in commercial media.
- Execute one photo shoot for two hours within the Kingston Metropolitan Area.
- Provide the Ministry with other recommendations required for successful implementation of a Public Awareness promotional strategy.
- Secure relevant approvals for photographic release duly signed by the appropriate authorizing agents.
- Create for the review of the Ministry's Public Relations Unit and the LMIS team the appropriate placement roster based on information related to the times and media that will effectively reach the majority of the target audience.
