The Government of Jamaica seeks a suitable **Consulting Firm** or a qualified **team of Consultants** to conduct a feasibility study of a proposed **Transportation Hub**.

Consulting Services ("the Services") are required to, inter alia, conduct a feasibility study to assess a proposal for implementing a Transportation Hub by undertaking financial, economic, social and environmental analysis of the proposed development, thereby facilitating appropriately informed decisions.

The Planning Institute of Jamaica now invites eligible consulting firms or teams of consultants ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services.
