



Request for Expression of Interest

The execution of Non – Destructive Testing for equipment at KCT Terminals

KCT Services Limited seeks to invite Expressions of Interest (EOI) from suitably qualified local and international companies and/or individuals for the execution of Non- Destructive Testing (NDT) on container handling equipment at our port facilities as per the Original Equipment Manufacturer's (OEM) and/or KCT Services Limited Engineering Division's recommendation(s).

The works will be conducted at Kingston Container Terminals, Port Bustamante, Kingston, Jamaica.

The Scope of Work

The scope of work entails Non-Destructive Testing for:

- o Quay Cranes
- o Quay Crane Spreaders
- o Reach Stackers
- o Empty Container Handlers
- o Twistlocks
- o Headblocks
- o Straddle Carriers; and
- o Other Components

Qualification Requirements

The individual or Company must possess the following qualifications to conduct NDT for the quay cranes:

- i. Valid American Society of Non-Destructive Testing (ASNT) Level III certification;
- ii. Valid American Welding Society (AWS) QC – 1 Certificate or equivalent Canadian (CAN/CSA), British Standard (BS) or European Standards (CEN);
- iii. Possess a working knowledge of all requirements of AWS D1.1:2014; and
- iv. Possess a working knowledge of American Institute of Steel Construction (AISC) specification for structural joints and fasteners.

The individual or Company must possess the following minimum qualification to conduct NDT on all other equipment listed above:

- i. Valid American Society of Non-Destructive Testing (ASNT) Level II certification.

The certification should cover the following areas:

- o Electromagnetic Testing
- o Liquid Dye Penetrating Testing
- o Magnetic Particle Testing
- o Radiography Testing
- o Ultrasonic Testing; and
- o Visual Testing

Equivalent Qualification Requirements

Equivalent qualification and certification must be from the following organizations:

- i. British Institute of Non-Destructive Testing (BINDT); or
- ii. Canadian Institute of Non-Destructive Evaluation (CINDE).

Requirements for the submission of EOI

Applicants for the EOI are requested to furnish the following information:

- i. Name of Company/ or Individual (as applicable)
- ii. Professional Profile
- iii. Copies of certification as specified above; and
- iv. Details of similar jobs undertaken.

Eligible companies and/or individuals will be shortlisted on the basis of the following criteria:

- i. Relevant experience of individual/ track record of company
- ii. Technical capabilities as per qualification requirement which is mentioned above; and
- iii. Qualification of the individual or key staff (for company).

Deadline for the submission of EOI

A sealed envelope containing one (1) original and two (2) copies of the EOI and clearly marked "Expression of Interest - The execution of Non – Destructive Testing for equipment at KCT Terminals" must be deposited in the tender box located in the Administration Building lobby, KCT Services Ltd. Port Bustamante, Kingston, Jamaica no later than 2:00 p.m., Friday, September 11, 2015. The opening of these EOIs will take place on Friday, September 11, 2015 at 2:15 p.m.

The KCT Services Ltd. requires all persons to complete a Gate Pass request via our website at www.kctjm.com.jm [e-Gatepass] in order to access the premises of the Kingston Container Terminal (i.e. the Terminal).

The name and particulars of the Bidder Representative(s) attending the Terminal must be properly outlined along with the specific location you will be visiting per the Invitation for Expression of Interest.

Requests must be made on a timely basis per the guidelines on the afore-mentioned website.

NOTE: The security screening process at the Terminal gate may be lengthy and KCT Services Limited accepts no liability for any inconvenience experienced as a result of this process including missed bid deadlines. Please note that the deadline date and time specified in the Bid Documents will refer to the date and time before which the Bid must be placed in the Tender Box in the specified location and not when you have arrived on the Terminal.

IMPORTANT: No offensive weapons, including firearms, are allowed on the Terminal.

Bidders should not request and will not be given access to drive onto the Terminal but will instead park in the main car park.

Upon arrival at the Terminal, the Bidder representative must have:

- o Valid identification documentation, such as Driver's Licence or Passport
- o Be appropriately attired, including properly enclosed footwear. Depending on the nature of the visit, the Bidder may be temporarily provided with additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) e.g. Reflective vest and hard hat.
