Update of Jamaican Taxation Registration Number (TRN) and Tax Compliance Information for participation in GOJ tender opportunities via the Electronic Procurement System:

All suppliers that have a Jamaican based Taxation Registration Number (TRN) are being asked to validate their (TRN) and Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) information on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Government Procurement System (GOJEP).

The purpose of a valid TRN in GOJEP is to:

- I. Verify Supplier's details;
- II. Allow for retrieval of Tax Compliance information for Supplier and;
- III. Facilitate the integration of the e-Tendering (GOJEP) System with Supplier's information in the Government's National Contracts Commission (NCC) registration system using the supplier's TRN as shared identifier between both systems.

To update your organisation's TRN and Tax Compliance data in the e-Tendering system, Supplier Admin Users must execute the following steps:

- I. Login to the system (www.gojep.gov.jm);
- II. Select the **Supplier management** link (under the Supplier Administration section on the left);
- III. Select the **Edit organisation** link/button;
- IV. For the **Taxation Registration Number (TRN)**: prompt – Enter your organisation's nine (9) digit TRN (no space or dashes). See TRN rules below;
- V. For the Taxation Compliance Reference (TCC) # prompt – Enter the last TCC# issued to your organisation by the Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), if one was issued. By completing this task:
 - a. Your organisation's Taxation Compliance Expiration Date information will be retrieved from the TAJ Taxation system and displayed on your organisation's record in GOJEP;
 - b. Tax eligibility information for your organization will print on the Tender Opening Reports generated by the system;
 - c. The system will send you an email reminder, fourteen (14) days prior to the expiration of your organization's tax compliance status. Upon the expiration and renewal of your TCC, please ensure same is updated in the system by following the above steps.
- VI. Select the Save button once you have entered the above information.

TRN Format Rules:

Organisation Type	Format	Rules
1 Limited Liability Incorporated	000009999	TRN must begin with digit 0 (Zero) and must be nine digits. No '-' or space shall be entered.
2 Partnership	000009999	TRN must begin with Zero and must be nine digits. No '-' or space shall be entered.
3 Sole Trader or Trading As Entity	100009999/0001	TRN must begin with the digit 1 and must be nine digits. A sub 4 digit number must be entered, example 0001 or 0002 or 0003 etc. No '-' or space shall be entered.
4 Individual Consultant	100009999	TRN must begin with the digit 1 and must be nine digits. No sub 4 digit number must be entered, No '-' or space shall be entered.

HIGHWAY 2000 – MOBAY PERIMETER ROAD, ST. JAMES REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO PROCURE APPRAISAL & NEGOTIATING SERVICES FOR ANY OF TWO (2) PACKAGES – BOGUE TO IRONSHORE

The National Road Operating and Constructing Company Limited (NROCC), acting on behalf of the GOJ, is in the process of effecting acquisition of lands to establish a Perimeter Road for Montego Bay as a project of Highway 2000 which expands the Toll Road system to the parish of St. James. The new project covers a Right of Way (ROW) corridor of some 100m width and extends for some 15km with interchanges which link to local road networks. Licensed Real Estate Dealers who are also Chartered Valuation Surveyors are invited to submit proposals for any of two (2) packages to carry out the following services in support of the Land Acquisition process:

- (a) Coordination with Surveyors/Designers to reference and identify property boundaries and the relevant owners and occupants of such lands affected within the Right of Way of the Highway and for realignment of local support roads and other infrastructure.
- (b) Negotiate with occupants/landowners based on agreed maximum valuations or relocation provisions.
- (c) Securing legal and vacant possession of the lands required to allow construction to proceed.
 - (i) Tabulation and submission of all information in graphical and written form in physical/hard copies and originals as necessary together with submission of all works electronically.
 - (ii) Provide deliverables and in such timely manner as agreed and to conform to regulations of the Land Acquisition Act and to standards based on international best practices and with such assistance/coordination provided by our Land Acquisition team.

Interested parties will be required to bid using only the prescribed Bid Proposal Form in the Tender Form and as guided by the Tender Document. Tender Documents for each package will be available from **Tuesday October 16, 2018** during our normal working hours, **8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.** each day from our receptionist at our offices for a non-refundable cost of \$3,000.

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR A GREEN CLIMATE FUND PROJECT DEVELOPMENT SPECIALIST

The Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation (MEGJC) has received a readiness grant from the Green Climate Fund to support private sector mobilization for the development of climate change adaptation and mitigation projects/programmes at the national and regional level. A portion will be used to engage a Project Development Specialist "Consultant" to provide private sector entities with training in project development with the aim of enhancing their capacity in building their business case to better access resources of the Green Climate Fund (GCF).

The specific objectives of the assignment are: (a) Convene an Inception Meeting with the National Designated Authority of the Green Climate Fund; (b) Design and launch the Request for Call for Project ideas; (c) Conduct a 2-day training workshop for shortlisted project proponents; (d) Prepare a report on workshop proceedings, recommendations for follow-up actions and training materials and a workshop evaluation report.

The implementation period of the above-captioned project is eighteen months (18) months. However, the consultancy work is two (2) months, commencing in January 2019.

The expressions of interest (EOI) will be evaluated based on the following criteria: (a) qualifications—candidate should possess at least an advanced degree (Masters or higher) in Project Management, Environmental Studies, Business Administration, Finance, Climate Policy or a relevant field; (b) at least four to five (4-5) years of proven experience in project/programme development and management in climate change, preferably in the Caribbean region or other Small Island Developing States; (c) demonstrate previous success in development and approval of multilateral-funded projects (Adaptation Fund, Global Environment Facility and Green Climate Fund). Experience with the Green Climate Fund is preferred; (d) Samples of work submitted demonstrating (i) at least three relevant projects developed over the last four to five (4-5) years which highlights their experience and (ii) excellent grant proposal writing and project development training; and (e) fluency in written and spoken English.

The Ministry of Economic Growth and Job Creation (MEGJC) now invites eligible Consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Services & to provide information demonstrating the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

Expressions of Interest (EOI) should not exceed fifteen (15) pages.

Consultants will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Government of Jamaica, Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures Volume 3 and 4, **March 2014**. It is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the policies.

Method of selection: Quality-Based Selection (QBS) method set out in the Procurement Policies. Further information can be obtained at www.megjc.gov.jm.
