REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST – INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANTS

The Government of Jamaica (GOJ) has received financing from the Caribbean Development Bank (CDB) – United Kingdom Caribbean Infrastructure Partnership Fund (UK CIF), in an amount equivalent to £35,515,000 towards the cost of the Essex Valley Agriculture Development Project (EVADP) and intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this financing to eligible payments under a contract for which this invitation is issued. Payments by CDB will be made only at the request of the GOJ and upon approval by CDB, and will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the Financing Agreement.

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce, Agriculture and Fisheries (MICAF) through a dedicated Project Execution Unit (PEU) intends to engage the services of a Marketing Specialist to support the implementation of the Project. The Consultant will be responsible for identifying and establishing marketing opportunities, contracts and linkages, which will promote investment in the project area as required by the Caribbean Development Bank and the Government of Jamaica in order to ensure the effective implementation of the project. The Consultant will be based in Kingston and will report to the Lead Consultant for the Enhanced Agricultural Production and Marketing Facilities and Systems who will be responsible for routine supervision and monitoring the progress of this consultancy.

The duration of this assignment is for a period of Twenty-Four (24) months.

MICAF now invites interested eligible individual consultants to submit Expressions of Interest (EOI) indicating their qualifications and experience required to provide this consultancy service.

Consultants shall be eligible if:

- The persons are citizens or bona fide resident of an eligible country;
- In all cases, the consultant has no arrangement and undertakes not to make any arrangements whereby any substantial part of the net profits or other tangible benefits of the contract will accrue or be paid to a person not a citizen or bona fide resident of an eligible country; and
- In all cases, the consultant is not subject to any restrictions under European Council Regulation No. 2580/2001 of 27 December 2001 or the Terrorism (United Nations Measures) 2009 of the United Kingdom with a view to combating terrorism.

Eligible countries are member countries of CDB.

Prospective candidates should have at a minimum:

- At least a Master's Degree in Marketing, Business Administration, Management or related area from a recognized institution;
- A minimum of five years' experience in Marketing within the agricultural industry or similar position. Experience working with international and donor organizations with implementation of participatory projects will be considered an asset;
- Experience in preparing marketing strategies and marketing plans;
- Experience in agri-business, agri-based small medium enterprise development;
- Understanding of financing options for business start-ups and business expansion;
- Strong analytical and operational knowledge of agri-business;
