The Bodles Redevelopment Project under the Research and Development Division of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce, Agriculture & Fisheries is in search of a consultant to design a new piggery building.

- Scope:** Design a modern Piggery considering environmental/climatic factors such as wind direction, travel pattern of sun and rainfall direction, with standard designs:
 - To conform to current planning and environmental legislation and production and local **SOP/GAPS** standards that can be operated to a standard production plan as part of existing farm or as new production facilities.
 - Finishing pens that can operate as 'all in, all out' facilities which match large-scale sow systems or units where batch production is practised.
 - Sow farrowing pens with feeders and waters that can accommodate a farrowing crate of dimension: length 2400mm, Width 650mm, height 1000mm.
 - Utility pens with feeders and waters for research purposes and offer flexibility in terms of construction options to suit different farming enterprises.
 - Provide scope for personal preferences in terms of feeding system, feed hoppers, drinkers and penning, and use of renewable and conventional energy.
 - Design perimeter fencing around buildings to ensure biosecurity is established.

- Design a suitable Biodigester to handle faeces and waste water from the operation and provide methane, water and organic manure to be reused within the farm enterprise. The Biogas system designed should ensure low levels of sulphur and other pollutants produced.
- Provide estimated cost for construction for all equipment, infrastructures and buildings designed.

The Consultant is expected to prepare an initial report to demonstrate their understanding of the project.

- Design and Access Statement describing the background and context of the proposal, why the location/orientation chosen, the reasoning behind the design/materials/colours used and how the site would be accessed from the roadway – even if only during the construction phase.
- If there are neighbouring properties in the vicinity, an independent risk assessment of: – Odour pollution – Noise pollution. Normally at least 35dB is permissible at any nearby dwelling (Manure and dirty water disposal can usually be explained concisely in Part 11 of the application form)
- A photomontage showing an impression of the completed building from three main angles for determination of the visual impact. Otherwise, a full visual impact assessment might be needed, including a landscaping plan provided by a landscape architect, especially in an area of outstanding natural beauty.

Update of Jamaican Taxation Registration Number (TRN) and Tax Compliance Information for participation in GOJ tender opportunities via the Electronic Procurement System:

All suppliers that have a Jamaican based Taxation Registration Number (TRN) are being asked to validate their (TRN) and Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) information on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Government Procurement System (GOJEP).

The purpose of a valid TRN in GOJEP is to:

- Verify Supplier's details;
- Allow for retrieval of Tax Compliance information for Supplier and;
- Facilitate the integration of the e-Tendering (GOJEP) System with Supplier's information in the Government's National Contracts Commission (NCC) registration system using the supplier's TRN as shared identifier between both systems.

To update your organisation's TRN and Tax Compliance data in the e-Tendering system, Supplier Admin Users must execute the following steps:

- Login to the system (www.gojep.gov.jm);
- Select the **Supplier management** link (under the Supplier Administration section on the left);
- Select the **Edit organisation** link/button;
- For the **Taxation Registration Number (TRN):** prompt – Enter your organisation's nine (9) digit TRN (no space or dashes). See TRN rules below;
- For the Taxation Compliance Reference (TCC) # prompt – Enter the last TCC# issued to your organisation by the Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), if one was issued. By completing this task:
 - Your organisation's Taxation Compliance Expiration Date information will be retrieved from the TAJ Taxation system and displayed on your organisation's record in GOJEP;
 - Tax eligibility information for your organization will print on the Tender Opening Reports generated by the system;
 - The system will send you an email reminder, fourteen (14) days prior to the expiration of your organization's tax compliance status. Upon the expiration and renewal of your TCC, please ensure same is updated in the system by following the above steps.
- Select the Save button once you have entered the above information.

1 Limited Liability Incorporated	000009999	TRN must begin with digit 0 (Zero) and must be nine digits. No '-' or space shall be entered.
2 Partnership	000009999	TRN must begin with Zero and must be nine digits. No '-' or space shall be entered.
3 Sole Trader or Trading As Entity	100009999/0001	TRN must begin with the digit 1 and must be nine digits. A sub 4 digit number must be entered, example 0001 or 0002 or 0003 etc. No '-' or space shall be entered.
4 Individual Consultant	100009999	TRN must begin with the digit 1 and must be nine digits. No sub 4 digit number must be entered, No '-' or space shall be entered.
