Update of Jamaican Taxation Registration Number (TRN) and Tax Compliance Information for participation in GOJ tender opportunities via the Electronic Procurement System:

All suppliers that have a Jamaican based Taxation Registration Number (TRN) are being asked to validate their TRN and Tax Compliance information (TCC/TCL) on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Government Procurement (GOJEP) System.

The purpose of a valid TRN in GOJEP is to:

- I. Verify supplier's details;
II. Allow for retrieval of Tax Compliance information for Supplier and;
III. Facilitate the integration of the e-Tendering (GOJEP) System with Supplier's information in the Government's National Contract Commission (NCC) registration system using the suppliers TRN as shared identifier between both systems.

To update your Organization's TRN and Tax Compliance data in the e-Tendering system, Supplier Admin Users must execute the following steps:

- I. Log in to the System (www.gojep.gov.jm);
II. Select the Supplier management link (under the Supplier Administration section on the left);
III. Select the Edit organisation link/button;
IV. For the Taxation Registration Number (TRN) prompt - Enter your organization's nine (9) digit TRN (no space or dashes). See TRN rules below;
V. For the Taxation Compliance Reference (TCC/TCL) # prompt - Enter the last TCC# issued to your Organization by the Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), if one was issued. By completing this task:
a. Your Organization's Taxation Compliance Expiration Date information will be retrieved from the TAJ Taxation system and displayed on your Organization's record in GOJEP;
b. Tax eligibility information for your Organization will print on the Tender Opening Reports generated by the system;
c. The System will send you an email reminder, fourteen (14) days prior to the expiration of your Organization's tax compliance status. Upon the expiration and renewal of your Tax Compliance, please ensure same is updated in the system by following the above steps.
VI. Select the Save button once you have entered the above information.

- 1. The National Irrigation Commission Limited (NIC) invites bids from eligible Bidders for the Supply and Delivery of 750mm HDPE Pipes for the NIC. As part of its strategic objective for the financial year 2019-2020, the NIC has set itself a target to rehabilitate the existing canal system utilizing the 750mm HDPE pipes in order to improve conveyance efficiency and reduce water seepage loss. Delivery time Three (3) to Four (4) months after signing of contract
2. To be eligible, local entities/Suppliers are required to be currently registered with the National Contracts Commission in the General Supply - irrigation equipment, pipes, fittings, valves and meters, and possess a valid Tax Compliance Letter/Certificate.

Bid Collection Period: Tuesday, April 2, 2019 to Friday, April 12, 2019 from 9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. The request for Bidding Document may be purchased upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Three Thousand Jamaican Dollars (J\$3,000.00) in cash or certified cheque payable to the National Irrigation Commission Limited and can be collected from the address above, accompanied by a Bid Security of Twenty-Five Thousand Jamaican Dollars (J\$25,000.00)
5. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after bid closing and must be delivered to the address above on or before 12:00 noon Thursday, April 18, 2019, and deposited in the Tender Box located in the Administrative Building (Conference Room) at the address above. Late bids will be rejected.

HIGHWAY 2000 - MONTEGO BAY PERIMETER ROAD PROJECT, ST. JAMES REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO PROCURE APPRAISAL & NEGOTIATING SERVICES FOR THE LONG HILL BYPASS PACKAGE 4 - BOGUE TO MONTEPELIER

The National Road Operating and Constructing Company Limited (NROCC) acting on behalf of the GOJ, is in the process of effecting acquisition of lands to establish the Montego Bay Perimeter Road Project of Highway 2000 which expands the Toll Road system to the parish of St. James. This Package 4 of the project, the Long Hill Bypass covers a Right of Way (ROW) corridor of some 100m width and extends for some 10.4 km, and now requires proposals from Registered Real Estate Dealers who are also Chartered Valuation Surveyors with the Royal Institute of Chartered Surveyors, to carry out the following services:

- A) Coordinating with the surveyors/designers to reference and identify the property boundaries and relevant occupant/owners of the lands within the Highway reservation or local support road realignments or other infrastructure and provide an opinion of market value or a range within which the value is likely to be settled in relation to the current/approved alignment. And delivery of Appraisal Reports within the timelines indicated.
B) Provide Process Server certification of having served and posted relevant notices under the Land Acquisition Act - Section 3 and Section 5 Notices.
C) Where negotiations are not capable of being pursued indicate referral for the issue of Section 9 notices and subsequent to the issue of such to provide process server information evidencing that the notices were appropriately posted/served to permit the Hearing to be effected and Section 15 Notices to be issued and so secure legal possession or alternatively where offers are agreed or negotiated, submit evidence of terms accepted to permit possession and to include executed agreements for the terms of purchase.
D) Secure and deliver such appropriately structured offers which conform to established appraisals for persons to effect resettlement by way of acceptance and in compliance with the basis of grants for structures and where crops will be required to be removed prior to being reaped in instances where lands are known to be unregistered and in so doing advance the process to secure vacant possession. Where necessary support the Section 9 and Section 11 processes under the Land Acquisition Act.

Interested parties will be required to bid using only the prescribed Bid Proposal Form in the Tender Form and as guided by the Tender Document. Tender Documents will be available from Monday April 1, 2019 during our normal working hours, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day from our receptionist at our offices for a non-refundable cost of \$3,000. Failure to fully comply with the requirements of the Tender Document could result in the rejection of the Bid.

NROCC reserves the right to employ more than one team as may be beneficial to the timely execution of the project and the right to nullify any or all bids and may not be held obligated to accept any qualifying bid.

Tender proposals are to be placed in the tender box located in NROCC's office reception area no later than Thursday May 2, 2019 at 3:00 p.m. local time. Proposals are to be in sealed envelopes addressed in the following manner:
