The Ministry of Finance & the Public Service wishes to advise that effective **April 1, 2019**, the Public Procurement Act will come into effect.

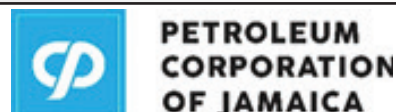
Consequently, the National Contracts Commission (NCC) will cease to exist and will be replaced by the establishment of the Public Procurement Commission (PPC).
