The PPC will have responsibility for endorsing recommendations for the award of Government contracts, making recommendations to Cabinet for the award of Government contracts as well as registering companies/businesses desirous of participating in the Government of Jamaica procurement process.

The general objective of the Programme is to support the efforts of the Government in restoring the competitiveness of the agricultural sector through the implementation of activities aimed at promoting market access by small and medium-sized farmers and the stimulation of private sector investments within the agricultural sector. The Tourism Enhancement Fund (TEF) invites tenders from suitably qualified entities to carry out **Architectural, Coastal/Civil/Structural/ Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, Quantity Surveying, Contract Administration, Land Surveying and Project Management Services**.

Scope of Works

The Tourism Enhancement Fund (TEF) has decided to develop the properties to include at a minimum and where applicable the construction of changing and restroom facilities, installation of perimeter fence, parking area, gazebos, bandstands and children play area, seating, walkways, landscaping, lighting, water supply, sewage treatment, provide shoreline protection (where applicable). These beaches are:

1. Alligator Pond Beach – St. Elizabeth
2. Winnifred Beach – Portland
3. Rio Nuevo Beach – St. Mary
4. Success Beach – St. James

Proposals will be accepted for individual or a combination of Beaches. There is no limit to the number of beaches one can bid on.

Failure to adhere to 1- 7 above will result in automatic disqualification of bid(s).
