Job Purpose

Under the direction of the Project Director, the Project Procurement Officer is responsible for all matters relating to procurement for the Agricultural Competitiveness Programme Bridging Project (ACBPB) and the Frosty Pod Unit of the Plant Quarantine/Produce Inspection Branch of the Ministry of Industry, Commerce, Agriculture and Fisheries. These activities include the preparation and administration of tenders/bids for the procurement of goods, works and services; purchase and maintenance of relevant inventory and associated records.

Specific duties of the Project Procurement Officer will include:

- Assisting in the preparing and maintaining of an annual procurement plan for the Agricultural Competitiveness Programme and the Frosty Pod Unit.
- Preparing tender/bid documents including Requests for Proposal (REP) and Requests for Quotation (RFQ) for both entities.
- Placing local and international advertisements through the appropriate media, inviting bids, proposals, quotations or applications in accordance with Agricultural Competitiveness Programme Bridging Project, the Frosty Pod Unit and government requirements.
- Screening bids to ensure they meet all the eligibility and prequalification criteria.
- Preparing and placing requisitions and follows through to ensure the satisfactory delivery of goods and services.
- Liaising with suppliers to resolve discrepancies regarding orders.
- Maintaining lists of qualified suppliers in keeping with the approved list from the National Contracts Commission.
- Maintaining and Updating relevant files and Contracts Register monthly.
- Preparing monthly procurement reports to the Project Director.

Other Responsibility

Performing other related functions assigned from time to time by the Project Director.

Qualifications

- First Degree in Business Administration, Quantity Surveying or in a closely related field.
- Specialized training in procurement or project administration and management
- At least two years experience in procurement activities on internationally funded projects

Update of Jamaican Taxation Registration Number (TRN) and Tax Compliance Information for participation in GOJ tender opportunities via the Electronic Procurement System:

All suppliers that have a Jamaican based Taxation Registration Number (TRN) are being asked to validate their TRN and Tax Compliance information (TCC/TCL) on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Government Procurement (GOJEP) System.

The purpose of a valid TRN in GOJEP is to:

- Verify supplier's details;
- Allow for retrieval of Tax Compliance information for Supplier and;
- Facilitate the integration of the e-Tendering (GOJEP) System with Supplier's information in the Government's National Contract Commission (NCC) registration system using the suppliers TRN as shared identifier between both systems.

To update your Organization's TRN and Tax Compliance data in the e-Tendering system, Supplier Admin Users must execute the following steps:

- Log in to the System (www.gojep.gov.jm);
- Select the Supplier management link (under the Supplier Administration section on the left);
- Select the Edit organisation link/button;
- For the Taxation Registration Number (TRN) prompt – Enter your organization's nine (9) digit TRN (no space or dashes). See TRN rules below;
- For the Taxation Compliance Reference (TCC/TCL) # prompt – Enter the last TCC# issued to your Organization by the Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), if one was issued. By completing this task:
 - Your Organization's Taxation Compliance Expiration Date information will be retrieved from the TAJ Taxation system and displayed on your Organization's record in GOJEP;
 - Tax eligibility information for your Organization will print on the Tender Opening Reports generated by the system;
 - The System will send you an email reminder, fourteen (14) days prior to the expiration of your Organization's tax compliance status. Upon the expiration and renewal of your Tax Compliance, please ensure same is updated in the system by following the above steps.
- Select the Save button once you have entered the above information.
