SUPPLY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF A 120KW SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC (PV) SYSTEM AT THE EBONY PARK PUMPING STATION

1. The National Irrigation Commission Limited (NIC) invites bids from eligible Bidders for the Construction of a 120kW Solar Photovoltaic (PV) System at the Ebony Pumping Station located in the parish of Clarendon. The NIC Limited, as part of its strategic objective for the financial year 2019-20, has set itself a target to reduce the increasing cost of electricity bills being experienced over the past few years. Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) Procurement Method, governed by the Government of Jamaica, Public Procurement Act 2018.
2. To be eligible, local entities are required to be currently registered with the National Contracts Commission in the Category Photovoltaic and Wind-Powered Systems, and/or Renewable Energy Systems, and possess a valid Tax Compliance Certificate/Letter (TCC).
