- **May Pen Infant School – May Pen District, Clarendon**
- **Patrick Town Primary & Infant School – Patrick Town District, Manchester**

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

May Pen Infant School – 8 months

The construction of a new ten (10) classroom Infant School building to include; sickbay, dining room, lunchroom, storeroom, kitchen and bathroom facilities as well as the renovation of the existing building in two (2) classrooms, administrative office and staffroom.

Patrick Town Primary School – 6 months

The construction of a new three (3) classroom Infant Department building to include; office, sickbay and bathroom facilities.

ELIGIBILITY:

It is mandatory that contractors be registered with the National Contracts Commission in the category of "Building Construction" Grade 1 for May Pen Infant school and Grade 2 and above for Patrick Town Primary & Infant school.

All bidders must be Tax Compliant at the bid opening. Bidding will be in accordance with tender procedures and guidelines specified in the Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures (March 2014).

SUBMISSION OF TENDERS:

The Tender/s along with the required documents i.e. NCC certificate of registration, a valid TCC/ TCL and Tender Bond are to be placed in a sealed envelope and placed in the designated tender box provided marked with the name of the respective schools which is located in the waiting area of the CHASE Office, 8 Belmont Road, Kingston 5 on or before **2:00 p.m. Friday, September 6, 2019**. Late Bids will be rejected.

The Electoral Commission of Jamaica invites eligible bidders to submit bids for delivery of handheld devices and applicable software development for an electronic voter identification solution.

Eligibility Requirements

Contractors should be registered with the Public Procurement Commission (PPC) prior to the award of the contract.

Tax compliance is not a requirement for foreign Bidders to participate in procurement opportunities. However, where the contract will be executed in Jamaica, the foreign contractor will be required to obtain a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) before the contract award.

Bidding documents will be available for download as at **July 31, 2019** on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Website – www.gojep.gov.jm. Registration instructions are also available on the website. Registration is required for vendors to participate in this tender opportunity.

Return of Tenders

Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm no later than **September 6, 2019 at 3:00 p.m.** An online bid opening will take place on the same date at **3:15 p.m.** An online bid opening report will be sent to all bidders who submit a bid.

This is an online Tender where tender documents will only be made available and accepted via electronic Government Procurement Portal (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) of bids will be accepted and there will be no physical tender box for drop-off of tender documents.
