Update of Jamaican Taxation Registration Number (TRN) and Tax Compliance Information for participation in GOJ tender opportunities via the Electronic Procurement System:

All suppliers that have a Jamaican based Taxation Registration Number (TRN) are being asked to validate their TRN and Tax Compliance information (TCC/TCL) on the Government of Jamaica Electronic Government Procurement (GOJEP) System.

- The purpose of a valid TRN in GOJEP is to:
I. Verify supplier's details;
II. Allow for retrieval of Tax Compliance information for Supplier and;
III. Facilitate the integration of the e-Tendering (GOJEP) System with Supplier's information in the Government's National Contract Commission (NCC) registration system using the suppliers TRN as shared identifier between both systems.

- To update your Organization's TRN and Tax Compliance data in the e-Tendering system, Supplier Admin Users must execute the following steps:
I. Log in to the System (www.gojep.gov.jm);
II. Select the Supplier management link (under the Supplier Administration section on the left);
III. Select the Edit organisation link/button;
IV. For the Taxation Registration Number (TRN) prompt - Enter your organization's nine (9) digit TRN (no space or dashes). See TRN rules below;
V. For the Taxation Compliance Reference (TCC/TCL) # prompt - Enter the last TCC# issued to your Organization by the Tax Administration Jamaica (TAJ), if one was issued. By completing this task:
a. Your Organization's Taxation Compliance Expiration Date information will be retrieved from the TAJ Taxation system and displayed on your Organization's record in GOJEP;
b. Tax eligibility information for your Organization will print on the Tender Opening Reports generated by the system;
c. The System will send you an email reminder, fourteen (14) days prior to the expiration of your Organization's tax compliance status. Upon the expiration and renewal of your Tax Compliance, please ensure same is updated in the system by following the above steps.
VI. Select the Save button once you have entered the above information.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Jamaica Urban Transit Company Limited (JUTC), located at Michael Manley Drive, Twickenham Park, Spanish Town, St. Catherine, is requesting the submission of proposal inclusive of quotations from entities with the ability and capacity to undertake the INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF AN ELECTRONIC FARE COLLECTION SYSTEM (EFCS).

Entities wanting to take part in this RFP process must be able to install and monitor the EFCS being proposed and said EFCS must be online 24/7 and should at least come equipped with the following functional requirements but not limited to:

- BOJ registered and approved Mobile Money Platform
• Have a robust platform that can withstand ANY potential threats (natural and man-made)
• System should be cloud based
• Full documentation for all categories of users on all component systems
• Crystal Reports (or other reporting tool) integrated into the software solution (please specify tool in comments)
• Database with integrated backup and purge procedures
• System designed to create and manage history files, i.e. all Smart Card transactions from inception will not be stored in one table. (suggestion : a table per year)
• System must operate online, real-time, but capable of working offline
• System must support mobile ticketing technology to allow passengers to pre-purchase bus tickets at anytime using their mobile phone
• The ticketing application must be integrated with the mobile money platform
• Other functional requirements as outlined in the criteria form

Also, the EFCS being proposed must be able to perform reports on the following:

- Ability to view revenue by: Driver, Bus, Route, Depot, POS. As Per: Day, Month, Period (start date and time - End date and time) Summary/Detailed (Totals for period/each transaction)
• Revenue earned broken down into cash and cashless transactions
• The ability to query transactions by class (ticket type), route, fleet or value
• Analysis by direction and time (giving boarding and alighting by stage, direction and time).
• Passenger, Fare Income and Cycle Trips per fleet number

Finally, the EFCS system must come equipped with, but not limited to, marketing functions such as automated text to alert low balance via SMS and pop-up advertisements.

The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for ROAD REHABILITATIVE WORKS: FAIRFIELD TO POINT ROAD located in the parish of St. James. The works consist of cleaning of bushing & trimming, removal of concrete structures, construction of concrete v drains, drain cleaning; scarifying, preparation of formation, base course, application of asphaltic concrete overlay.

Eligibility: It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC)/Public Procurement Commission (PPC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grade 1 in the Civil Engineering Works or General Road Works Categories. Tenderers must have a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC).

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

Jamaica Urban Transit Company Limited (JUTC) in an effort to efficiently and effectively meet the demands of the daily commuters, invites bidders to submit proposals for the operation of a franchise consisting of 10 routes in Portmore (17, 17A, 1, 1A, 3, 3A, 20, 20A, 18 and 18A).

To effectively cover the routes to be franchised, your proposal should factor for a total of 100 buses. Said buses should be as follows:

- 50 Electric Vehicles (EV)**
• 50 LNG/CNG**

**All Buses are to be equipped with the Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) which can provide data analytics when requested. Of the 100 total, twenty (20), should be Articulated Electric Vehicles (EV) and eighty (80) 55-seater coach style or low floor to be included in the mix to facilitate the transporting of large number of commuters at any given time.

The initial duration of the franchise will be for three (3) years. However, there will be a ten (10) year renewable contract subsequent to the successful completion of the initial three (3) years.

A monthly franchise fee payment of JMD 200,000.00 will be required for each route. Timeframe for Implementation should be on or before October 31, 2019.

NOTE TO BIDDERS: JUTC, Ministry of Transport and Mining (MTM) and International Transport Authority rules and regulations will apply.
