WINDALCO/KIRKVINE COLD STORAGE FACILITIES PROJECT, MANCHESTER (#073577)

Scope: The construction of a Cold Storage Facility with three (3) 40-ft shipping containers, this will involve the installation and retrofitting of two (2) 40-ft refrigerated containers to provide cold storage capacity of 141.5 cubic metres – (one (1) container for ethylene producing crops and one (1) for non – ethylene producing crops) and the installation and retrofitting of one (1) 40-ft. container to provide dry storage capacity of 70.7 cubic metres. Construction also entails substructure water storage tank, external works, sewer treatment systems and building placement on the proposed project site. Standby generator WILL BE done, and the PV system will NOT be done. **Construction period is six (6) months.**
