- The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Youth Employment in the Digital and Animation Industries Project (YEDAIP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contracts for the procurement of computers and networking equipment for Components 1&3. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, except for those payments, which the contract provides to be made through letter of credit.
- The Office of the Prime Minister now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the supply of computers, computer peripherals, and networking equipment for training institutions (offering animation training) and community centres as follows:

- Bidders may Bid for one or several contracts, as further defined in the request for bids document. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded more than one contract will be allowed to do so, provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Bid.
- As a condition precedent for the award of contract:
 - Local suppliers will be required to submit a Public Procurement Commission, formerly National Contracts Commission (NCC) Certificate, in the category of Information Technology Services or Computers and Related Services and, a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) or Tax Compliance Letter (TCL).
- Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 ("Procurement Regulations") and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
- Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from the Office of the Prime Minister, Procurement Specialist, ibrdyedaip@opm.gov.jm and inspect the bidding document during office hours 0900 to 1600 hours at the address given below.
- The bidding document in English may be obtained by interested Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below or to email address: ibrdyedaip@opm.gov.jm. The document will be sent by email for overseas suppliers and by local mail or email for local suppliers. Alternatively, the documents can be collected at the address given below.
- Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **11:00 a.m. on November 15, 2019**. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **November 15, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.**
