The Students' Loan Bureau (SLB) is a Government of Jamaica owned and operated financial institution and is an agency of the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service. Its primary mission is to provide affordable and flexible loan financing to Jamaican students attending approved tertiary educational institutions (Universities, Colleges, etc.).

The Bureau seeks to procure and implement a Loan Management Information System (LMIS) for the computerization of its core operational areas including Customer Online Portal, Loans and Documents Management, Collections Management, Teller-Payments and Analytics Reporting.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures, 2014.

A. Scope of Project:

- i. Provision of a Loan Management Information System-based solution
- ii. Implementation, Configuration and Customization of the system in keeping with the defined requirements of the project and including data conversion and multiple third-party system interfaces.
- iii. Provide technical support, training and product warranty.

B. Eligibility Requirements:

To establish eligibility, Bidders must comply with the following criteria at the time of bid submission:

- i. Proof of certification from manufacturer(s) to implement and support the systems being proposed **OR** Declaration of ownership of the Software signed by a Notary Public.
- ii. Overseas and Local bidders will be required to obtain National Contracts Commission (NCC) Registration in any one of the following categories: Computers & Related Services, OR Computers and Supplies, OR Information Technology Services, if they are selected for contract award. It is not required at the time of bid submission.
- iii. Overseas and Local bidders will be required to obtain a valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC) if selected for contract award, where any aspect of the contract will require work to be done in Jamaica. It is not required at the time of bid submission. For more information on acquiring a TCC: http://www.jamaicatax.gov.jm.

C. Collection of Bid Documents and tender participation:

The tender is being managed through the Government of Jamaica's electronic Government Procurement system **www.gojep.gov.jm** and a complete set of Bidding documents in English is available for download from the website. Registration on the website is required to access the Bid documents and to participate in the Tender. Registration instructions/user manual are available on the Home page of the site under the 'First-visit' guide section. Bids must be submitted online via www.gojep.gov.jm system no later than November 8, 2019 at 10:00 a.m., Jamaica time (UTC-5). Bidders must follow the Special Instructions provided for Bid Submission.

F. First Stage Bid Opening:

Online (Electronic) Bid opening will take place on **November 8, 2019 at 10:15 a.m. Jamaican time.** An online Bid opening report will be sent (via the e-GP System) to all Bidders that submitted a proposal.
