The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Youth Employment in the Digital and Animation Industries (YEDA) Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds towards payments under the contract for the supply and delivery of multifunction printers/scanners/copiers. For this contract, the Borrower shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the World Bank's Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing.

2. The Office of the Prime Minister (OPM) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the supply and delivery of five (5) multifunction printers/copiers/scanners.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the national competitive procurement using Request for Quotation (RFQ) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" July 2016 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
