In keeping with the Government's commitment to strengthen and promote Public Procurement, the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service (MOF&PS), Office of Public Procurement Policy (OPPP) is on a drive to expand the use of the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement System (GOJEP) to its suppliers of goods, services and works. This is in keeping with the commitment of the Government to all procurement opportunities published and managed through GOJEP.

Suppliers are being urged to register their businesses in GOJEP and take advantage of the free training sessions facilitated by the Ministry of Finance and the Public Service in the use of the system during the month of August.

Availability of Bid document and Bid Submission: This is an online tender where tender documents, clarifications and bids will only be made available and accepted via the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement Portal-GOJEP (www.gojep.gov.jm). No offline (hard copies) will be accepted and there will be no physical tender drop-off of tender documents.

- Clarification period – no later than 7 working days (**Monday, December 30, 2019**) before bid submission deadline.

Submission deadline: Tenders must be submitted by via GOJEP no later than **Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.**

Bids will be opened using the online platform; as such, there will not be a public tender opening exercise. The system will forward the tender opening report to all bidders who submitted bid proposal.

Late bids will be automatically rejected by the system.

Bidding will be conducted through the National Competitive Bidding (NCB) procedures as outlined in the Government of Jamaica Handbook of Public Sector Procurement Procedures, March 2014 (<http://www.mof.gov.jm>) and is open to all bidders locally.
