The National Works Agency invites eligible contractors to submit tenders for **ROAD REHABILITATION OF SAVANNAH CROSS, LOCATED IN THE PARISH OF CLARENDON**. The works consist of site clearance, earthworks, excavation to reduce levels and pavement works such as sub base course, base course, prime coat and asphaltic concrete overlay 50mm thick; walling, masonry and fencing; drainage construction of kerb and channel and installation of traffic signal and signs.

**Eligibility:** It is mandatory that contractors be on the National Contracts Commission (NCC)/ Public Procurement Commission (PPC) List of Registered Contractors at the specified level in any of the following categories for their tenders to be eligible: Grade 1 or 2 in the Civil Engineering Works or General Road Works Categories.
