Description of Service: The design, supply & installation of Renewable Energy (Solar Photovoltaic) at Hamilton Gardens & Portmore Commercial Office.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Tenderers must submit:
- A valid Tax Compliance Certificate (TCC)/valid Tax Compliance Letter (TCL) at the bid submission deadline
 - A valid registration certificate from the Public Procurement Commission, formerly NCC in any of the following categories at the bid submission deadline:
 - Electrical Works (minimum Grade 2)
 - Renewable Energy Systems
 - Photovoltaic and Wind-Powered Systems Design
 - Photovoltaic and Wind-Powered Systems - Installation, Maintenance and Repairs;

Bidders **MUST** be registered on the GOJEP system in order to access the bidding documents and participate in the tender. Registration can be done by following the instructions listed on the website at www.gojep.gov.jm. Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days after bid closing date.

Bid Submission & Opening:

Bids must be submitted online via in the Government of Jamaica Electronic Procurement website www.gojep.gov.jm no later than **Thursday, January 23, 2020 at 2:15 p.m.** Online bid opening will take place at 2:30 p.m. on the same date. An Online Bid Opening Report will be sent to all bidders. The system will automatically reject late bids.
